Duties: Under the general supervision of the Information Systems Branch Supervisor, the Associate Information Systems Analyst Specialist (AISA) independently or on a team plans and organizes tasks for acquisition, design, building, testing, implementation, maintenance and support of the CCC's complex network infrastructure and desktop management systems.

The incumbent will have frequent contacts with CCC managers, district directors and staff throughout the state; consults with private consultants and vendor representatives concerning the needs and development of IT systems.

Ensures the stability and integrity of the CCC's data and wireless network services by performing in the capacity of an IT expert and works independently or on a team for tasks related to the planning, implementing and managing of the CCC enterprise information systems and complex network infrastructure including Local Area Networks (LAN), Wide Area Networks (WAN) and wireless network across the organization.

Performs in the capacity of an IT expert on tasks and works independently or participates in a team related to planning, designing, implementing and supporting of desktop imaging creation and deployment using distributed infrastructure, desktop vulnerability mitigation and patch management.
